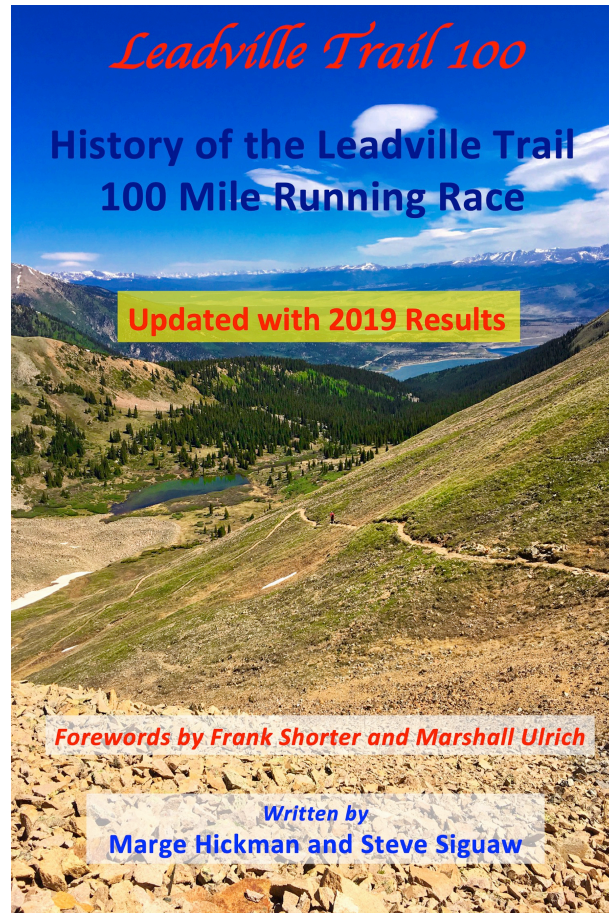

Epilogue

On Friday, November 22, 2019, Marge received an email from the new race director for the Leadville Trail 100, Timothy Brosious. Marge deferred her entry from the 2019 race until the 2020 race because of an injury. Deferrals to the next race year are allowed by race rules, as explained on the Life Time Fitness Race Series website.

This is the response Marge received when she was banned from the race: “Unfortunately at this time the Leadville Race Series will not be able to grant entry into the race. I know you’ll understand why we’ve come to this decision after the differences between you, your husband, the Race Series and Ken and Merilee. I know we have not met in the past and trust me this is not the way I wanted to have an introduction.

With those three short and cowardly sentences, Marge was denied the opportunity to become the oldest woman finisher in the history of this once great race. All the hype and hyperbole about being part of the “Leadville family” seems to have gone by the wayside. At least the majestic mountains and enticing forest trails in the Colorado Rockies remain timeless.

Chapter 14

A New Millennium

2019

Record snowfall in Colorado during the winter caused massive avalanches with debris covering all the Leadville trails. Even the Hardrock 100 mile race in Silverton, Colorado was cancelled because of too much snow on that course this year.

The Forest Service and other volunteer groups worked diligently to make sure the Leadville course was runnable for the race. Only one snowfield remained near the top of Hope Pass on race day. When August 17th rolled around, the Leadville Trail 100 trails were all open with a field of 828 runners standing at the warm starting line. (NOTE: the U.S. Forest Service permit stipulates a maximum of 900 athletes)

Warm starting line? Yes, the race this year saw temperatures soar into 70's during the race, something very rare at the high altitude of Leadville in August.

Contending for the men's championship crown this year was Jared Hazen, 2nd place finisher at Western States 2019 (14:26:46) and Gediminas Grinius from Lithuania who finished in 6th place at Western States 2019. Fast Colorado runners Ryan Smith along with Devon Olson, not to mention Chad Trammell from Alaska rounded out a strong men's race.

For the women's race field, Cat Bradley, 2017 Western States women's champion in 19:31:30 and Magda Boulet, 2015 Western States champion in 19:05:21 were at the starting line. Returning champion from 2018 Leadville Trail 100, Katie Arnold, was also ready for another championship attempt.

Forty-eight states and forty-one countries were represented this year, with the youngest entry twenty years old and the oldest entry seventy-three. The starting field was comprised of 78% male and 22% female runners. The cost for the 2019 Leadville Trail 100 race was set at \$335 plus processing fees.

How did the race shake out this year? Well, the women's race went as expected with Magda, Katie and Cat fighting for the lead position. Magda lead the women's field through the Twin Lakes aid station, enroute to Hope Pass, with a twenty-minute lead over Katie and Cat running another fourteen minutes behind. Katie subsequently dropped out, leaving Cat in second place for the climb over Hope Pass.

Magda's lead dwindled to thirteen minutes ahead of Cat at the Winfield turnaround. Once at the Outward Bound Aid Station and twenty-three miles from the finish line, Magda had extended her lead to a little over an hour in front of Cat.

In downtown Leadville, first woman to cross the finish line was Magda Boulet, 46, from California with an official time of 20:18:07 and 11th overall (she was in 10th place overall but faded). Cat Bradley, 27 from Nederland, Colorado finished as 2nd place woman, with a time of 20:45:48. Samantha Wood, 34 from Colorado Springs, Colorado was the 3rd female, finishing in 23:52:04 and 50th overall. Samantha was also the 2018 Leadwoman champion. Rounding out the fourth place women's position was Carrie Stafford from Vail, Colorado in 51st position overall, right behind Samatha in a time of 23:55:20.

For the men, it was a close race during the initial stages. Jared was running only a minute ahead of Chad and three minutes ahead of Ryan at the Outward Bound Aid Station. Jared was on course record time at this point in the race. Jared's wicked pace took a toll on him. During the climb up Hope Pass, Jared was finished for the day, as he turned around and returned to Twin Lakes. The new leader was Chad who led Ryan and Devon to the top of Hope Pass. At the Winfield turnaround, all three men were within a few minutes of each other with Chad still in the thin lead.

Ryan then took over the lead, inbound over Hope Pass, and never looked back. Ryan picked up his new pacer with only twenty-three miles to the finish line and it was none other than 2019 Western States female champion Clare Gallagher, who ran with Ryan all the way to downtown Leadville.

Crossing the finish line and becoming the 2019 Leadville Trail 100 champion was Ryan Smith from Boulder, Colorado with a time of 16:33:2, 8th fastest time in race history. Second place was captured by Chad Trammell in 17:56:26 followed fifty-six seconds later by Devon Olson in third place with a time of 17:57:17. What a finish, with three men running under 18-hours! Rounding out fourth place was Ramon Casanovas from Chile with a time of 18:14:51. Marvelous Marvin Sandoval captured eighteenth place by running 21:06:58.

Chasing the Grand Slam of Ultrarunning record, Gediminas Grinius (Lithuania) was seventh overall in 19:22. Although Gediminas had time on Ian Sharman's record 2013 Grand Slam campaign, after the Slam's first two races, Gediminas lost a bunch in Leadville, stating afterward that the altitude was a challenge for him. Sharman ran Leadville in 16:30:03 during 2013 in setting the Grand Slam of Ultrarunning record.

David Mackey finished once again with a time of 25:54:59 in 98th place overall. Another Leadman finish for him!

Race conditions for the 2019 Leadville Trail 100 mile running race were unseasonably warm, although there was no snow, hail or rain to contend with. Yet the warm conditions resulted in a finishing percentage of only 45% with a total of 374 finishers out of 828 starters.

Also, during the race, there was a significant problem. The U.S. Forest Service closed the Winfield dirt road to vehicle traffic for all crews because of debris and damage caused by avalanches during the previous winter season. This road closure resulted in significant long delays for runners who dropped out at the fifty-mile point in Winfield. Race management arranged for a shuttle service company to ferry DNF runners from Winfield back to Twin Lakes. However, at the last minute, the contracted shuttle service company did not show up, leaving volunteers from local Arkansas River rafting companies and even race management trying to return runners to Twin Lakes in private vehicles. Long waits at Winfield were typical for many exhausted runners.

2020

There will once again be a lottery for the 2020 Leadville Trail 100 with the lottery held on January 19, 2020. There is no qualifying standard for a runner entering the Leadville Trail 100. No prior ultrarunning experience, no specific race times and no volunteer work is required to enter the race. Race date for the 2020 Leadville Trail 100 is August 22, 2020. Entry fee for the lottery is \$335 plus processing fees.

There are other ways to gain entry into the 2020 Leadville Trail 100 besides the lottery process. If you sign up for the Leadville Trail 100 Running Camp plus Entry package, you are guaranteed an entry into the race at a cost of \$1,000.

New for 2020 is a Coaching package called “Life Time Endurance – Premium Coaching”. Subscribing for this option on the official race website, a runner will receive personalized coaching and education from a choice of four coaches to guide their training program. The package also offers discounts for other associated events like the Trail 100 Run Camp and All-Access Pass. All this can be purchased at a cost of \$2,900. That price includes guaranteed entry into the race, of course.

Similarly, charity slots will again be available from the Leadville Trail 100 Legacy Foundation that provides entry into the Leadville Trail 100 race. An applicant simply makes a one-time payment to the Legacy Foundation for a minimum amount of \$2,350 to get a guaranteed spot in the running race. Slots are limited.⁷

Finally, unsuccessful lottery applicants or those failing to gain entry by paying large sums of money can run one of Life Time Fitness’s qualifier events to earn an entry, after paying for one of those events and running a qualifying time as explained on the website. Hmmm.
